This past weekend, **Women's Club Soccer** hosted Yale University, University of Pittsburgh, West Virginia University, American University, Cornell University, and The College of New Jersey for a tournament. Penn State, Cornell, WVU, and Pitt all advanced to the playoffs. In the first semifinal Pitt beat Cornell 5-4 in penalty kicks and Penn State beat WVU 5-0. In the championship game, Penn State won 1-0 against Pitt. With this tournament win, the women moved to number one in their region's rankings. The regional tournament will take place the weekend of October 17th and 18th where they hope to qualify for Nationals.



Club Golf defeated WVU in the Border Cup by a score of 402-409 on September 20th at Champion Lakes Golf Course in Ligonier, Pennsylvania. Rob Levensood was a medalist with a 76. This past weekend, they hosted an Intersquad Tournament on Penn State White Course. Chris Senesac and Zach Royer scored low scores of 78 and 79, respectively.
